

Product Description: DuraCoat Paint Remover is an all purpose paint remover specially designed for the removal of synthetic, cellulose and stoving paints from their respective substrates.

Thinning: Not recommended.

SPECIFICATION

- 1) Apply by brush a generous coat of DuraCoat Paint Remover onto surfaces where the old paint is to be removed. Allow to react for above few 5 minutes before stripping off the softened paint film with scrappers.
- 2) To enhance faster performance of DuraCoat Paint Remover, the surface of the paint to be removed should be scoured with wire brush prior to applying the paint remover.
- 3) Removal of multi pack “epoxies” or “polyurethanes” may require repeated applications as aged coats in these categories could be harder to remove.
- 4) Ensure thorough cleaning prior to painting. If possible use stronger solvents to mop clean the DuraCoat Paint Remover at the end of the exercise.

PRECAUTIONS

- (I) Since the chemicals used are corrosive it is recommended that hand gloves and goggles are worn when using DuraCoat Paint Remover.
- (ii) **DO NOT** smoke when using DuraCoat Paint Remover since Nicotine from cigarettes will react with components of the remover to give phosgene gas which is highly toxic.
